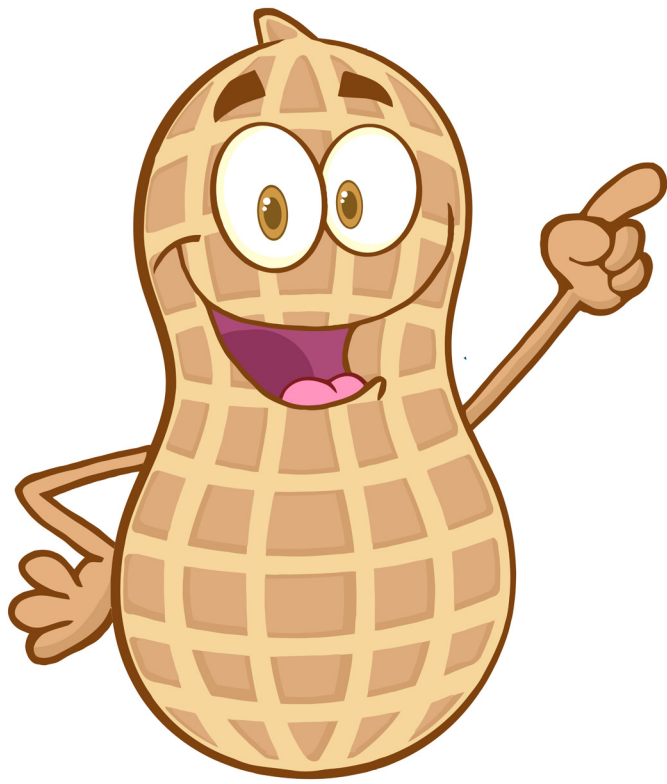
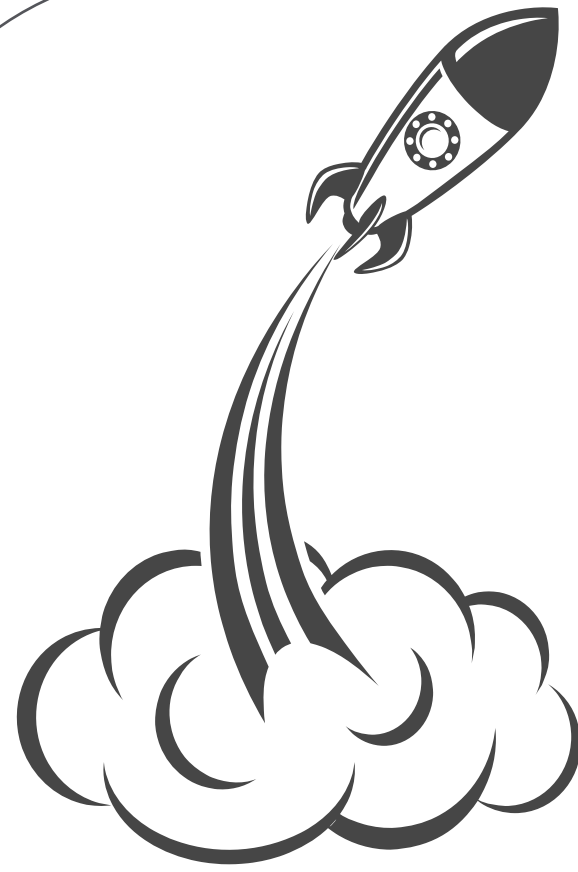


FUN FACTS ABOUT PEANUTS

It takes one acre of peanuts to make approximately 30,000 peanut butter sandwiches.



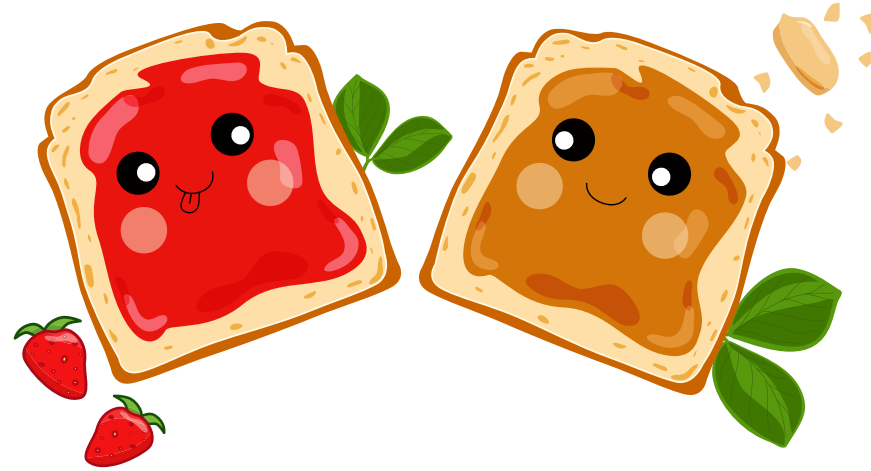
Alan Sheppard brought peanut butter along on his 1971 moon launch as a good luck charm.



75% of US households have at least one jar of PB; with men preferring chunky and women smooth



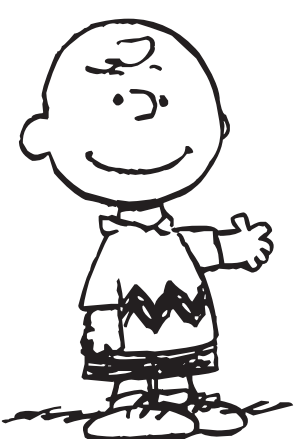
In the US, the average person consumes 3 lbs of PB a year; but in the EU consumption is 7.5 grams.
